

COOPERATING BROKER'S REQUEST FOR LISTING BROKER'S CONFIRMATION OF PRESENTATION OF OFFER TO SELLER/LANDLORD

1. Basis of this request: National Association of REALTORS® Standard of Practice §1-7 (Amendment 1/20) states, in pertinent part: "Upon written request of a cooperating broker who submits an offer to the listing broker, the listing broker shall provide, as soon as practical, a written affirmation to the cooperating broker stating that the offer has been submitted to the seller/landlord, or a written notification that the seller/landlord has waived the obligation to have the offer presented." Not providing the written affirmation requested below could be grounds for an Ethics complaint to be filed against you, which could result in punishment pursuant to the National Association of REALTORS® Code of Ethics and Arbitration Manual.¹
