

Mass Membership Email Feature Policy

- 1. The Mass E-mail feature is to be used for sending information and announcements related to real estate listed by the sender or real estate that the sender is attempting to source for a client. Any other use is prohibited.
- 2. Use of the mass email system to communicate compensation is prohibited.
- 3. Sender may not refer to any Real Estate Brokerage other than the office in which the sender's license is held.
- 4. Sender may not include any contact information for any other person other than themselves.
- 5. Sender may not refer to or mention any other licensed REALTOR® by name or inference. Unless for the purpose of co-sponsoring real estate related events (i.e. open house, happy hour, combined effort marketing, etc.)
- 6. No complaints may be sent over the mass email system. This includes but is not limited to complaints against other REALTORS®, Brokers, Affiliates, Title Companies, Lenders or Service Providers.
- 7. Brokers are not allowed to use the system to recruit other members to their brokerage.
- 8. Penalties for violations are as follows:
 - 1st infraction Warning
 - 2nd infraction \$50.00 fine; and 30-day removal of access to the email feature
 - 3rd infraction \$250.00 fine and the member will be permanently barred from using the mass email feature.

Note: Any member wishing not to receive such mass mailings can choose to be removed. Instructions to unsubscribe are provided by the SPIBOR thru the resources section in the Navica system.
